- Public Comment During Open Meetings
 - Content-based restrictions violate First Amendment
 - Policy banning "negative" public comments is unconstitutional
 - Griffin v. Village of Ruidoso, NM, et al., CIV-13-0799 JB/GBW (N.M. Dist Ct., 6/18/14).



- Public Comment During Open Meetings
 - Pending lawsuit challenges content-neutral ban on public comment
 - Citizens arrest, sue park district board members who refused to allow public comment
 - Allen v. Clark County Park District, et al., 2014-MR-18 (Clark Co. Cir. Ct., 2014)



- Confidential agreements not actually confidential
 - PAC rules FOIA trumps confidentiality provisions in governmental contracts
 Belleville News-Democrat v. St. Clair County, 2014 PAC 27773 (PAC op. 14-004)



- Police reports may not be withheld in their entirety
 - Police reports cannot be fully exempt from disclosure
